Introduction

Institution Information and Statistics

This section includes each members institution estates and teaching space information that has been collected via The Space Util Group's Peer Group Comparison data collection form.

Headline Institution Frequency, Occupancy and Utilisation Comparison

This section includes the headline space frequency, occupancy and utilisation results for each institution, plus key statistics for each institution that can have an effect upon the results i.e. % percentage of total teaching space NIA surveyed.

Space Type Frequency, Occupancy and Utilisation Comparison

This section includes the space type frequency, occupancy and utilisation rates for all institutions. Each space type is provided with a separate analysis section, enabling members to quickly and easily compare their space type usage against other institutions.

Day and Timeslot Frequency, Occupancy and Utilisation Comparison

This section includes the day and timeslot space frequency, occupancy and utilisation rates for each institution. This enables members to compare how their use of space during the teaching week differs to other institutions.



- Room Ownership (i.e. Department) Frequency, Occupancy and Utilisation Comparison
 Includes the room ownership teaching space frequency, occupancy and utilisation
 results for all institutions. Members can use this section to compare how each of their
 departments usage of teaching compares to other institutions.
- Space Norm Comparisons by Space Type

Compares each institutions space norms for each space type, this time enabling institutions to compare how many m2 they assign per workplace, for each space type.
